

City of Pretty Prairie Dump Site Rules and Regulations

The dump site is for City utility account holders ONLY! This includes those that live outside of the City limits but receive City utilities.

Each active account will receive a unique 5-digit code that allows entrance into the dump site during set hours of operation. Daily hours will be posted at the entrance.

The dump site is under video surveillance.

DO NOT give your code to anyone who does not live at your address! If they violate the rules and regulations, YOUR code will be deactivated. If your account has an unpaid balance, the code will be deactivated.

If YOU violate these rules and regulations, your code will be deactivated for 60 days and you could be assessed fines per Ordinance No. 171.

The dump site has specific areas where grass clippings/leaves are collected, where brush/limbs are collected, and where bulky trash is collected. Please make sure you are dumping in the correct areas.

GRASS CLIPPINGS/LEAVES are located near the south end of the site. Only grass clippings and leaves are allowed to be dumped here. Clippings/leaves must be loose and not in bags.

BRUSH/LIMBS are located near the center of the site. Limbs must be NO LONGER than 6' and NO BIGGER than 12" in diameter.

BULKY TRASH should be deposited IN the 40-yard roll-off dumpster located on the north side of the dump site. The following items are not allowed:

- Large appliances (Nisly will pick these up for free at your property if you call ahead)
- Mattresses
- Batteries
- Liquids or chemicals (this includes paint)
- Tires
- Drums or containers
- Biohazardous waste
- Construction Demo Material (see back page for list)

When the dumpster becomes too full, maintenance will padlock the door for safety reasons. If you are unable to lift heavy items over the top of the dumpster, you are allowed to leave the items on the side of the dumpster and maintenance will use their equipment to lift it over the side. DO NOT leave small, loose trash on the outside of the dumpster.

If you have an excess of rubbish which is more than a pickup load, please order your own dumpster. This is a community service and is not intended for major property cleanup and/or renovations.
